## Local Transportation

Marietta is a suburban, residential area and public transportation is limited. Bus station is a quarter of a mile from the school. There is also a bus (# 10) that stops at the entrance of SPSU. Students may take bus 10 directly to the Art Center and then take the MARTA train in Atlanta to travel in Atlanta. The price for the bus and for MARTA is \$1.75 per ride.

## Smoking Policy

Smoking is not permitted at the ELS Center but students may easily go outdoors to smoke in designated areas. Smoking is not permitted in Residence Hall Apartments.

## Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

## Student Residence / Dorm Apartment

Males & females are placed in separate apartments although apartment floors are coed. American students of SPSU also live in the same facility and may reside on the same floor.

### Rooms (standard option): Single (1 person)

Private study bedroom within a shared 4 bedroom on-campus apartment. Shared bathrooms (2 per apartment). Each apartment has a furnished kitchen, living room with dining area and washer & dryer. Rooms include bed, dresser, desk with chair, a telephone, and internet connection. Linens are also included. Students clean their own rooms and share responsibility for cleaning the apartment during their stay.

Meals Included: **None** - Can purchase meal card after arrival. The average cost for breakfast is \$4.75 and \$6.25 for lunch and dinner. Meal card is \$25 for five meals.

Age Minimum: **18+ years old**

Laundry Facilities: Washer and dryer included in apartment building. No additional cost.

Security/Resident Assistant: Campus Police twenty-four hours a day seven days a week. There is one resident assistant for the apartment building.

Check-In: 12 noon to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in  
Upon arrival, report to the campus police "Building V" at 1100 South Marietta Parkway, Marietta, GA 30060 for check-in assistance. A police attendant will ask for the student's name. The ELS Greeter or Residence Assistant on duty is then called and will meet the student at their assigned apartment to let them in and the apartment key will be in their assigned room. Students should not remove luggage from the taxi/car until they reach the apartments (after the call from "Building V"). Damage deposit required.

Damage/Key Deposit: \$100 damage deposit

## Homestays

Rooms: **Single (1 person)**

Meals Included: **14 per week** (daily continental breakfast & dinner)

Age Minimum: **16+ years old**

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students use a bus to come to the campus.

Check-In: 10:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in  
Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 2:00 pm (Saturday)
