Local Transportation

Public transportation in the Boston area is excellent as both buses and subway (The "T") serve this area. The bus runs along Massachusetts Ave and stops outside the center. The red line "T" stop is one half mile from the center. Students receive complimentary city and subway maps. Subway fare is \$2 per trip. Bus fare is \$1.50 per trip. 7-day unlimited subway/bus linkpass cards are \$15, but most students choose the unlimited monthly linkpass for \$59. Students also have the option of purchasing rechargeable subway/bus cards that provide a discount off of the standard travel rates.

Smoking Policy

Smoking is not permitted in the ELS Center or any Cambridge College building. Smoking is permitted outdoors behind the building only.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

Rooms (standard option): **Double (2 person) or quad (4 person)**

The International Guest House is comprised of three lovely Brownstone row houses. Students live in spacious double or quad rooms with semi-private bathrooms (2-4 people). Rooms include a bed, dresser, desk and chair for each resident. Refrigerator, microwave, TV, phone, and cable connections are available in each room. Linens are also included. Wireless internet connection is available for an additional fee.

Meals Included: **14 per week** (breakfast and dinner daily)

Age Minimum: **16+ years old**

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available for a small fee.

Transportation to ELS: Residence students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students use the subway or bus to come to the center.

Check-In: **2:00 pm – 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in**
During standard check-in hours, students with confirmed reservations should check-in at the International Guest House, 237 Beacon Street, Boston. Students arriving later than noted check-in hours should plan to stay in a hotel unless other arrangements were confirmed.

Damage/Key Deposit: \$200 damage /key deposit

Rooms: **Single (1 person)**

Meals Included: **14 per week** (daily continental breakfast & dinner)

Age Minimum: **17+ years old**

Center Arrival Information

New Students should report to the ELS Boston Center at **8:30 am on the first Monday** of their program for registration, the ELS placement test and orientation. New students need to bring the following items:

- ☐ Passport, 1-94 card and I-20 form (if applicable)

- ☐ Proof of medical insurance (or funds to purchase ELS insurance)
