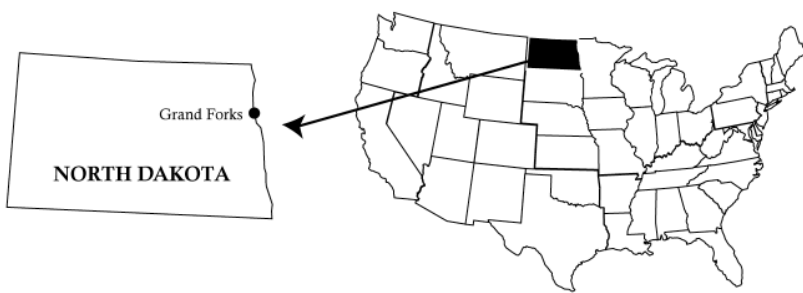

Local Transportation

Grand Forks is accessible by the city area transit bus (\$1.20). There is also a free university bus that transports students throughout the large campus area.

Smoking Policy

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

Rooms (standard option): Doubles (2 person)
Shared typical on campus dorm room. Shared hallway bathrooms. Rooms include: in room computer line & cord, cable TV line & cord, and ARH programming. Students also have access to the complex computer lab, residence hall fitness center and services provided by the complex centers. Linens, towels, blankets and pillows are not provided. A limited number of singles available upon special request (for extra cost). Students clean their own rooms during their stay.

Meals Included: Includes 15 meals per week.

Age Minimum: 17+ years old

Slightly younger students may be allowed in the option with the highest minimum age. Center Director approval required before booking.

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available in the same dormitory building for a small fee.

Security/Resident Assistant: There is one resident assistant for each floor or wing (1 per approx. 40 students).

Check-In: 4:00 pm to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in
Students with confirmed reservations report to the front desk of Wilkerson Hall. If arriving after official check-in hours, call 777-3565 and ask for "Wilkerson Service Center" for assistance with ELS dorm check in. Students who arrive late or have difficulty can call the Sunday arrival toll free number. Students who arrive before 4:00 on arrival Sunday will need to let ELS Language Centers know in advance so we can make special arrangements for early check-in.

Damage/Key Deposit: None

Checkout Time: 11:00 am (Saturday)

Homestays

Rooms: Single (1 person)

Meals Included: 16 per week (daily continental breakfasts/dinners with lunches added on weekends)

Age Minimum: 17+ years old

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students arrive at the campus by bus. Some families are close and provide bicycles for our students. Some families are also within walking distance of the campus.

Check-In: 12 noon to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in
Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 1:00 pm (Saturday)

Airport Arrival Information

Center Arrival Information

New Students should report to the ELS Grand Forks Center at **8:00 am on the first Monday** of their program for registration, the ELS placement test and orientation. New students need to bring the following:
