### Climate

La Verne enjoys a year-round warm, mild climate. Pleasant summers are just right for sportswear of all types. Winter evenings are cool (jackets are needed), but most days tend to be sunny and warm. A raincoat is recommended for winter showers.

### Local Transportation

Local buses serve local La Verne vicinity at approx. \$1.00 per ride or \$25 per month for a bus pass. Students can also use the Metrolink train from the Pomona North station in nearby Pomona (3 km) to go to Los Angeles Union Station (\$9.50 roundtrip weekends) and beaches (\$16.25 roundtrip weekends).

### DMV-Obtaining a California Driver's License

An International Driving Permit is recommended. Students may obtain a California driver's license. Required documents include passport, I-20, and proof of auto insurance when taking the driving test.

### Smoking Policy

## HOUSING & ARRIVAL DETAILS – LA VERNE

### On Campus Dorm

(Limited space during academic year;  
unlimited space during session 7 and 8)

**Rooms (standard option): Doubles (2 person)**

Shared typical on campus dorm rooms. Shared hallway bathrooms. Rooms include 2 single beds, 2 desks, 2 dressers and closets. Rooms are well lit with big windows. Males and females may NOT share the same room in the dorm; however, males and females are housed on the same floor.

**Linens:** Not provided. Students should bring or purchase upon arrival: extra long twin sheets, blanket/comforter, pillow, towels, alarm clock.

**Meals Included: None** – Meal card may be purchased after arrival for \$125 for 20 meals. On campus cafeteria prices are: Breakfast: \$5.19, lunch: \$6.49, and dinner: \$7.29.

**Age Minimum: 17+ years old/14+ years old session 7 and 8**

**Laundry Facilities:** Self-service machines (small fee)

**Security/Resident Assistant:** Key entry to dorm rooms. Dorm advisor is on staff until 10 pm to ensure all guests leave by 10 pm. There are Resident Assistants in each residence hall.

**Check-In: 12 noon to 10:00 pm (Sunday)**

During standard check-in hours, on campus dormitory students with confirmed reservations go directly to the Oaks Residential Complex, Building E for check in. Call (909) 973-4729 for RA to check-in and lock-out.

**Damage/Key Deposit:** None. \$50 for lost keys.

**Check-Out Time:** 11:00 am (Saturday)

### Sheraton Suites Fairplex Hotel

**Rooms (standard): Doubles (2 person)**

Shared hotel rooms with shared bathroom. Rooms contain linens, 2 beds, a desk, chairs, table, microwave and mini refrigerator. Weekly housekeeping & free weekday shuttle service to ELS. [Note: Rooms may be tripled in the case of overflow. If this occurs, student will receive a discount.]

**Meals Included: None** – May be purchased locally or may purchase on campus meal card after arrival.

**Age Minimum: 18+ years old**

**Internet Access:** \$100/month wireless access in hotel or \$100 credit for dial-up service

**Laundry Facilities:** Cost is \$1.50 per load

**Security:** 24-hour security at the front desk. Private key card access to individual rooms.

**Check-In: After 3 pm (Sunday)**

The front desk clerk provides rooms keys and will ask for a credit card guarantee (for any extra services).

**Damage/Key Deposit:** None

**Check-Out Time:** 12 noon (Saturday)

### Homestays

**Rooms: Single (1 person)**

**Meals Included: 14 per week** (daily continental breakfasts/dinners with lunches added on weekends)

**Age Minimum: 14+ years old**

**Phone Usage:** Students should purchase a phone card for international phone calls.

**Flight Information:** Homestay students should notify their Host Family or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

**Transportation to ELS:** Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Students generally commute to the campus by bus, foot or bike.

**Check-In: 8:00 am to 9:00 pm (Sunday)**

Students go directly to the homestay address.

**Check-Out Time:** 1:00 pm (Saturday)

**Other Transportation Options From the Airport:**

Taxis from LAX will cost about \$80 plus tip, with a travel time of 60 to 90 mins. Students can also arrange their own transportation on Super Shuttle, Tel: 1(800) 258-3826 toll free at a cost of about \$51 per person plus tip. From ONT airport a taxi costs about \$30 plus tip and takes 15 to 30 minutes. The Super Shuttle 1(714) 282-7507 can be arranged from this airport at a cost of approximately \$27 per person plus tip.
