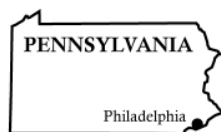

Local Transportation

Philadelphia has a good system of buses, trains and subways under the name of SEPTA, which connects with other train systems that reach most areas of the Northeastern USA. Philadelphia buses and subway fares range from \$1.30 to \$2. The 30th Street train station, 15 minutes from ELS by bus, provides access to train service to New York City, Washington D.C. and beyond.

Smoking Policy

Smoking is not permitted in the ELS Center. Smoking is also not permitted in Rashford Hall, Homewood Suites or the homestays.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. It is not possible to check into the dormitory or homestay before Sunday.

Student Residence / Dorm Apartment

Males & females are placed in separate apartments although floors are coed. American students live in the same residence hall, but on different floors.

Rooms (standard option): Doubles (2 persons in each bedroom)

Shared bedrooms within 2-bedroom campus apartment-style dorm. Shared bathrooms (2 per apartment). Each apartment offers a furnished living room, dining area, and kitchen and has free cable TV, internet access and local telephone service.

Rooms include 2 beds, 2 desks, 2 closets & 2 night tables. Linens are also included.

Rooms (other): Married Couple Rooms

Married couple rooms may be available with advance notice, but both the husband and the wife must study at ELS.

Meals Included: None - Most students prepare their meals in their dorm kitchens. If students wish to purchase cafeteria meals, a typical meal would cost \$6.

There are many restaurants in the area.

Minimum Age: 17+ years old

Laundry Facilities: Coin-operated washers and dryers (small fee) are located on each floor.

Security: 24-hour Security Desk at entrance; Card access. There is a resident assistant for ELS students.

Check-In: 8:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

During standard check-in hours, report directly to Rashford Hall at 5200 City Avenue. A security guard will be inside the building and will call the ELS Residence Advisor, who provides apartment check-in assistance and room keys.

Damage/Key Deposit: \$100 damage deposit payable on first day of class in cash or travelers checks

Checkout Time: 10:00 am (Saturday)

Homewood Suites

Note: When Rashford Hall is full, students will be placed in beautiful double-occupancy apartments at Homewood Suites at the nearby Hilton Hotel. Students will be notified 2 weeks prior to the start of the session if their dorm assignment is to the Homewood Suites.

Homestays

Rooms: Single (1 person)

Meals Included: 14 per week (daily continental breakfast & dinner)

Age Minimum: 17+ years old

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Families or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students walk or take the university shuttle to campus.

Check-In: 8:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 10:00 am (Saturday)

Other Transportation Options From the Airport:

Taxis from Philadelphia Int'l airport will cost approximately \$40 plus tip, with a travel time of 30 minutes. Taxi drivers should be given the following directions for dorm/student residence students: Go to 76 West to Exit 339 (Saint Joseph's University), take City Avenue to 52nd Street (turn left), Rashford Dormitory driveway is on the right.

Center Arrival Information

New Students should report to ELS Philadelphia **between 8:00 am and 8:20 am on the first Monday** of their program for registration, the ELS placement test and orientation. New students need to bring all of the following:

- ☐ Passport (plus I-94 card & I-20 form - if applicable)
- ☐ Funds to pay tuition and housing and other relevant fees (or receipt showing pre-payment)
- ☐ Proof of medical insurance (or funds to purchase ELS insurance)
- ☐ Materials contained in the acceptance package
- ☐ *Campus Apt Dorm Students Only:* Completed & Signed Health Form. This form is included in the acceptance package.
