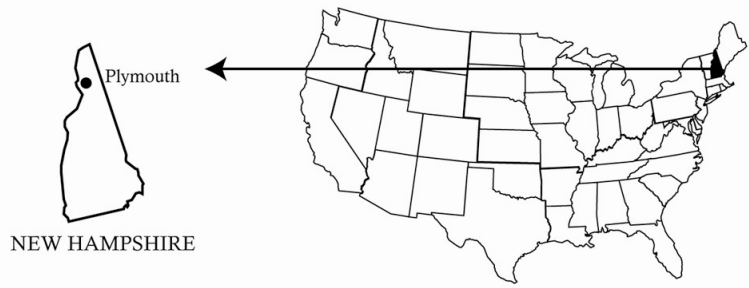

Local Transportation

Plymouth is accessible by the free Plymouth State University shuttle which runs weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 12 a.m. A shuttle runs every thirty minutes on Saturday and Sunday from 1:00 p.m. - 5:30 p.m. which stops at the local WalMart and grocery store. The shuttle runs every twenty minutes from 6 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.

Concord Trailways Bus runs once each day to Boston and the bus stop is located within five minutes of the campus. The Boston airport (Logan) is accessible through Concord Trailways or through Buckboard Travel.

Smoking Policy

All buildings are smoke-free. Smoking is allowed outdoors, at least 20 feet from building entrances.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is the Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval. Please see "Check-in" instructions in the following sections for exact arrival details and times.

Student Residence / Dorm **Mary Lyon Hall** **Plymouth State University** **Plymouth, New Hampshire**

Rooms (standard option): Doubles (2 person)
Shared typical on campus dorm rooms. Shared bathrooms (1 "male or female only" shared bathroom per wing). Rooms include a bed, closet or wardrobe, desk, and chair. Internet access is provided and cable access. Linens are also included. Students clean their own rooms during their stay.

Meals Included: Dorm student are **REQUIRED** to purchase a meal card upon arrival. Available meal plans range from \$260 up, with several choices available. The dorm price does **NOT** include the Meal Plan, but it is required.

Age Minimum: 17+ years old

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines are available in the same dorm building for a small fee.

Security/Resident Assistant: Each student is provided with his/her own set of keys for their dorm rooms, and access to the building. Only students living in Mary Lyon Hall have keys that will allow them access to the residence portion of this facility. There is a Resident Assistant (RA) to help students in the dorms. The RA is a student employee who lives in the hall.

Check-In: 1:00 pm to 9:00 pm (Sunday) check-in
Students with confirmed reservations report directly to Public Safety for check-in assistance into the residence hall. Students arriving later than noted check-hours should plan to stay in a hotel unless other arrangements were confirmed.

Damage/Key Deposit: Each student must complete a credit card authorization form in order to cover any incurred expenses in the event of damage or lost key at the time of check-out.

Checkout Time: 12 noon (Saturday)

Homestays

Rooms: Single (1 person)

Meals Included: 14 per week (daily continental breakfasts/dinners with lunches added on weekends)

Age Minimum: 16+ years old

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: TBA. Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students arrive at the campus by bus. Some families are close and provide bicycles.

Check-In: 12 noon to 9:00 pm (Sunday) check-in
Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 12 noon (Saturday)

Center Arrival Information

New Students should report to the ELS Plymouth Center at **8:30 am on the first Monday** of their program for registration, the ELS placement test and orientation. New students need to bring the following items:
