Local Transportation

San Rafael is Marin County's transportation "hub" so students can walk 15 minutes from the campus to a large bus terminal, or take a bus directly from the campus. Local bus service costs \$2 per ride. Bus round trip fare to San Francisco is \$8.70. Buses also connect with new high-speed ferries that cross to downtown San Francisco (approximately \$13.50 round trip). Students can also take buses to go to many of Marin County's famous towns like Sausalito and Tiburon (\$4.00 round trip). They often also take taxis together.

Smoking Policy

Smoking is not permitted in the ELS Center or Student Home, but students may easily go outdoors to smoke.

Housing Check-in and Departure

Students with confirmed ELS housing reservations should go directly to their assigned housing upon arrival (not to the ELS Center) on the Sunday before their course begins. Checkout is Saturday after the program ends. Arrivals and departures on dates/times other than those listed require special approval.

Summer Only On Campus Dorm

Available June 1 – August 22

Rooms: Doubles (2 person)

Shared on campus dorm rooms. Shared suite-style bathrooms (with 1 other room). Rooms include beds, dressers and/or closets, desks, chairs, telephones, high-speed internet access and cable TV. Linens are also included.

Meals Included: 19 per wk (breakfast, lunch, dinner)

Age Minimum: 14+ years old

Rooms (standard option): Doubles (2 person)

Shared rooms in nearby furnished student residence. Shared bathrooms, some in hallway, some private. Separate male and female sections. Rooms contain beds, desks (with highspeed internet access), chairs and closets. Facility offers 2 furnished living rooms (with cable TV/DVD/Video center), large kitchen, recreation room, and local telephone service. Daily shuttle service to ELS. Linens are also included.

Rooms (other): Triples (3 person); Single (1 per.)

Triple, or single rooms may be available at a different price upon special request, or space availability.

Meals Included: None – Students have the option (at extra cost) of eating in the campus cafeteria, walking to the Northgate Mall food court, or preparing their own meals in the large and fully equipped onsite kitchen.

Age Minimum: 17+ years old

Laundry Facilities: Self-service machines (small fee).

Security/Resident Assistant: There are separate male and female sections in the student home. All rooms have separate locks. There is an on-site student “Resident Assistant” to help students, and a 24-hour management Help Line.

Check-In: 12 noon to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

Damage/Key Deposit: \$200 collected upon arrival (\$10 deducted per session for cleaning)

Checkout Time: 10:00 am (Saturday)

Homestays

Rooms: Single (1 person)

Meals Included: 16 per week (daily continental breakfasts/dinners with lunches added on weekends)

Age Minimum: 14+ years old

Flight Information: Homestay students should notify their Host Family or ELS of their arrival times so that families will know to be home when they arrive.

Transportation to ELS: Host family students are responsible for their personal transportation. Most students commute to ELS by bus, or bicycle, although there are a few families within walking distance.

Check-In: 8:00 am to 10:00 pm (Sunday) check-in

Students go directly to homestay address.

Checkout Time: 10:00 am (Saturday)

Other Transportation Options From the Airport:

The Marin Airporter offers shuttle service from San Francisco Int'l airport to San Rafael Transit Center in San Rafael at a cost of \$18 plus tip. Domestic arrivals may catch the Marin Airporter just outside the baggage claim area of the terminal. International arrivals should go outside through Door # 3 (outside customs). Board the Marin Airporter at stops marked with signs "Hotel Shuttle Buses". The shuttle runs every half hour from 5:30 am to midnight. Once at San Rafael Transit center students may phone for a taxi 485-1234.
