- d) An original scholarship letter from your government or other organization.

Arrival and Departure

At all locations, ELS asks you to arrive the Sunday before your classes are to begin, and depart on Saturday, after your classes end. On your first Monday at ELS you will register for your program. After registration, you will take a placement test and evaluation interview so ELS can place you in the most appropriate level. You will then attend an orientation for newly arriving students.

Registration and Payment of Fees

On the first Monday of your program, you will need to arrive at your Center to complete registration for your program.

Please bring the following items with you:

1. Passport
2. A copy of your I-20 Form
3. Your I-94 form (Arrival/Departure record filled out on your flight to the US)
4. Funds to pay all remaining fees at ELS
5. Completed Health Form (if applicable)
6. Proof of medical insurance (if not purchased through ELS)

All fees are payable in full when you register for each session. ELS works with many counseling agents around the world who can provide you with information and assistance. Select ELS agents are authorized to collect monies on behalf of ELS. If the agent who assists you has such an arrangement with ELS, any refund for which you may be eligible, may be coordinated with this agent. For a list of agents visit www.els.edu/agents

Instructional Hours

The Intensive Program and Business English Program consist of the equivalent of 30 instructional lessons per week (6.5 lessons per day Monday through Thursday, and 4 lessons on Friday). The Semi-Intensive Program consists of 20 instructional lessons per week (4 lessons per day Monday through Friday). The American Explorer Program consists of 15 instructional lessons per week (3 lessons per day Monday through Friday). Summer @ the Juilliard School program consists of 16 or 18 instructional lessons per week. The Complete Prep Program for TOEFL® iBT consists of the equivalent of 30 instructional lessons per week (6.5 lessons per day Monday through Thursday, and 4 lessons on Friday). The first day of each session and 2 hours of the last day of each session may be devoted to placement and evaluation, registration and other non-instructional activities.

Attendance

Because ELS would like you to get the maximum benefit from your program, you will be expected to attend classes full-time. If you have excessive unexcused absences from any combination of classes in any session, you will fail the level unless you make up the work missed and are able to demonstrate mastery of the material covered. More than 18 unexcused hours in the Intensive Program, or 12 or more in the Semi-Intensive Program could cause you to fail your level. Students are eligible to take a one-session break in study after four consecutive sessions of study. Advance written notice and a \$50 vacation deposit are required.

Center Hours

All Centers are open from 8 am to 5 pm Monday through Friday, except on national holidays as listed below. If a holiday falls on a registration Monday, the Center will be open for newly arriving students, even though no classes will be held on that day.

Currency

All fees listed are in US Dollars.

Application Fee

A non-refundable, \$145 (\$100 for New York - Juilliard, New York - Manhattan, New York - Riverdale and Garden City) application fee is required with your completed application in order to process your enrollment.

Tuition Fee

Tuition fees are as listed in the "2010 Prices & Dates" document. To take advantage of the long-term, discounted programs, you must pay the tuition for all sessions before starting your program at ELS.

Housing Fee

All housing fees are listed on pages 2-4 of the "2010 Prices & Dates" document. Housing prices are subject to change. A housing reservation deposit of \$200 per session (\$400 for New York - Manhattan) is required for each session ELS reserves for your accommodations.

Student Health Plan Fee

All ELS students must have medical insurance coverage while in the US. If you cannot provide evidence of sufficient coverage, in English, for medical expenses incurred while studying in the US, you must purchase the ELS Student Health Plan. The Student Health Plan is offered to ELS students at a non-refundable fee of \$120 per 4-week session (\$110 per Summer @ the Juilliard School session). You will receive additional information about the Student Health Plan when you arrive at the Center.

Airport Pick-Up Fee

If you would like ELS to arrange airport pick-up upon your arrival, please indicate this under question 15 of the application form. The fees, by Center, are listed on the following pages of this document.

Materials and Technology Fee

ELS, a leading English provider, offers you a unique curriculum that includes exclusive proprietary textbooks and materials, as well as state-of-the-art Language Technology Centers. ELS will give you the appropriate textbooks and materials for each level you attend. Each student pays a non-refundable Materials and Technology fee of \$65 (except for students in the Complete Prep Program for the TOEFL® iBT, Prep Program for the GRE® or GMAT® and the Summer @ the Juilliard School program) at the beginning of each session attended.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Tuition and Fees

If ELS does not accept your application, ELS will refund you the application fee.

If ELS accepts your application, and you cancel your enrollment, the fee will not be refunded. However, should you cancel, you may apply your application fee toward a new enrollment for up to 12 months after your initial scheduled start-date.

If you cancel your enrollment prior to the start of the session, or your visa application is rejected, ELS will refund all pre-paid tuition and fees (except the application fee and courier fee.)

Student health plan fees are not refundable.

Housing Fees

The \$200 (\$400 for Manhattan) per session housing deposit will be refunded if you cancel or defer with more than 28 days' written notice. If you cancel with fewer than 28 days' notice, ELS will retain up to a maximum of two sessions of housing deposit.

Housing Refund Policy

Refund policies for housing vary by location and are determined by the Center's college/university, or housing association.

All Refunds

You must make your refund request in writing.

Refunds will be made within 30 calendar days of your cancellation, withdrawal or termination from the program.

ELS follows all applicable state and federal regulations, including those related to student refunds.

Tuition Refund Policy

Standard Programs (Intensive, Semi-Intensive, American Explorer and Business English):

During your first 4-week session of enrollment you will not be eligible for a refund of tuition or fees, or to change from the Intensive to the Semi-Intensive or American Explorer program.

If you withdraw during your second or subsequent session of study, you will be eligible for a prorated tuition refund. This refund will be calculated from your last recorded day of attendance and will be prorated by week. ELS counts any part of the week that you studied as a full week of attendance for refund calculations. There will be no refund after the midpoint of a session (end of second week of study during a 4-week session).

There is a one-time \$150 program change fee if you change your enrollment from the Intensive to the Semi-Intensive or American Explorer program in your second or subsequent session of enrollment.

Complete Prep Program for TOEFL® iBT:

In addition to the tuition refund policy stated above, if cancelling a 12-week or 8-week Prep program, tuition used will be calculated based on 4-week session prices.

Long-Term Package Programs:

The long-term, pre-paid programs offer special discounts and a different refund policy applies:

If you withdraw at any point during your first 4-week session of enrollment, you will be charged for the first 4-week session at the standard (full) price, and you will be refunded the tuition for the balance of your pre-paid sessions, less the difference between the full price and the discounted price.

If you withdraw during your second or subsequent session of enrollment, you will be eligible for a prorated tuition refund. This refund will be calculated from your last recorded day of attendance and will be prorated by week. ELS counts any part of the week that you studied as a full week of attendance for refund calculations. There will be no refund after the midpoint of a session (end of second week of study during a 4-week session). When calculating refunds, all tuition used in the session you withdraw, as well as previous sessions taken, will be charged at the standard (full) price. You will also be charged the difference between the full price and the discounted price for the unused sessions of your pre-paid tuition, and you will be refunded the balance.

During your first 4-week session of enrollment in the Intensive Long-Term package program, you are not eligible to change to the Semi-Intensive Long-Term package program. There is a one-time \$150 program change fee if you change your enrollment from any Intensive Program to any Semi-Intensive Program in the second or subsequent session of your original booking.
